<u>CLUB UPDATE 4/8/2020</u>: COVID-19 – All soccer activities are currently suspended until further notice

Hello friends and family of Hurst United Soccer Association/Bayern Munich. Your recreational and competitive boards came together last night to discuss all of what we have been individually gathering from city officials, school districts, other clubs and associations to ensure we are doing what is best for you and our children.

Our current stance is that ALL physical gatherings for practices, games, scrimmages, tryouts, tournaments, team travel or any other team related events are PROHIBITED until further notice for ALL recreational and competitive teams.

We completely understand the hardships that these current times are placing on our families and communities at large. The city of Hurst has been an incredible resource in providing updated information and allowing HUSA to remain proactive in our approach as it is related to gatherings and getting back on track. They have already approved weeknight games, and holding games all the way through June. They have approved re-configuring HAC fields to allow 11v11 games to be held in addition to them preparing for their Fireworks show.

We are exploring every avenue and trying to be as transparent and innovative as we can to get through this process. We are working with all other associations around North Texas to come up with solutions to provide the service you deserve during these times of uncertainty. We are looking at things such as extending the season through the summer and adding small tournaments.

For Bayern families: We are currently following the guidelines of the leagues that we are enrolled in. From our conversations with them, they are currently in the same state and we are working with surrounding clubs to make sure everyone is working together on this. We have asked about the financials, understand that all clubs/leagues are in the same situation in that we have paid dues, and are in suspension, not cancellation at this time. We understand this has a ripple effect on tournaments, signings, tryouts etc. Everyone has agreed to keep all financials status quo until April when we have a better idea on what will happen.

Thank you to everyone in our HUSA Community for your understanding as we work together through this global pandemic. It is in these times that we must come together and support one another to do what is best for everyone!
